SWFL MICRO ENTERPRISE

The MicroEnterprise Institute of SWFL, a program of Goodwill, targets the un- or underemployed individual who is interested in being their own boss. This six week, twelve session course will help to determine if their business idea is feasible. They will work with seasoned entrepreneurs to develop a plan for the start-up and operation of their business. Working in small groups with an existing business owner allows participants to apply the information they are learning directly to their own business idea during each class session. A comprehensive workbook developed by the Kauffman Foundation makes creating the plan easy. Subject matter experts in the areas of accounting, legal, marketing, insurance and lending are incorporated into the classes so participants leave with knowledge of additional resources they can use as they start-up their business. Graduates are eligible to apply for a microloan that can assist in the financing of their business.

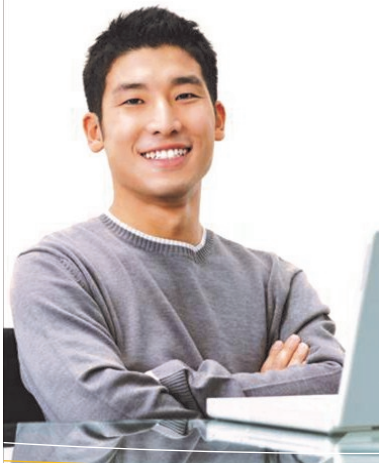
